A student seeking placement in Grade 9 U.S. 1 Level 1 must meet the following 4 criteria: <br> - Teacher recommendation based on demonstrated achievement/ability as evidenced by classroom performance and/or assessments <br> - B or higher in Grade 8 Social Studies <br> - B or higher cumulative average on all Social Studies Benchmarks <br> - PSAT $8 / 9$ EBRW score of 430 or better | US History 2 Level 1 <br> Students earning an A- final course grade in US History 1, Level 2 may seek placement to US History Level 1 by attaining the following criteria: <br> - Teacher recommendation based on demonstrated achievement/ability as evidenced by classroom performance and/or assessments <br> - Final Grade of A- or higher in US1 Level 2 <br> - Final Grade of A- in grade 9 English Level 2 |
